

That the El Paso Republican Organization meeting shall be held at Discovery Canyon Campus, 1810 N Gate Blvd. Colorado Springs 80921 on February 11th, and that any other districts who choose to have their El Paso District Organization Meetings on the same date and location shall be held at the conclusion of this El Paso Republican Organization Meeting;

That a new call be sent as soon as possible to all members of the El Paso Republican Central Committee and that the call requirement in the El Paso Bylaws be waived and that any notice requirements to be a candidate for any office also be waived;

That the meeting shall be called to order and be chaired by Temporary Chairman, Gregory Carlson, Professional Registered Parliamentarian, with Kevin Tebedo, Professional Registered Parliamentarian serving as Parliamentarian; That the credentials committee shall consist of the five County Commissioner District Chairmen in El Paso, along with one member selected by Vickie Tonkins and one member selected by Peak United Republicans. That the County Commissioner District Vice Chairman shall be a member of the Credentials Committee in the absence of their County Commissioner District Chairman. The Credentials Committee shall conduct a meeting before the Organization Meeting, which may be held electronically, chaired by Temporary Chairman Gregory Carlson, PRP with Kevin Tebedo, PRP serving as Parliamentarian to determine the eligible membership of the El Paso County Republican Party, and that all parties are invited to bring evidence and witnesses to the meeting; and that the El Paso County Chair provide the current list of the El Paso Central Committee and their contact information to the State Party the next day after this motion is adopted for use by the Credentials Committee;

That the Temporary Chairman may appoint the Rules Committee and the Teller Committee and make other appointments or appoint any other necessary committees for the conduct of the Organization Meeting, and that all of these appointments expire at the conclusion of the meeting;

That the following rules shall be adopted and be in force for the Organization Meeting, that these rules shall not be suspended, that these rules expire at the conclusion of the meeting, and that the El Paso Republican Central Committee may adopt its own rules that are not in conflict with their Bylaws or these rules:

- 1) Only credentialed members of the El Paso Republican Party Central Committee, those named in this motion, and other volunteers invited by the Temporary Chairman for the purpose of assisting with the meeting shall be entitled to enter the building and attend the meeting. The meeting may be broadcast for members of the public to watch.
- 2) The Organization Meeting shall not be adjourned until all business in the agenda required in the El Paso Bylaws to be conducted at the Organization Meeting has been accomplished.
- 3) The Temporary Chairman may order the removal of members who are disrupting the meeting.
